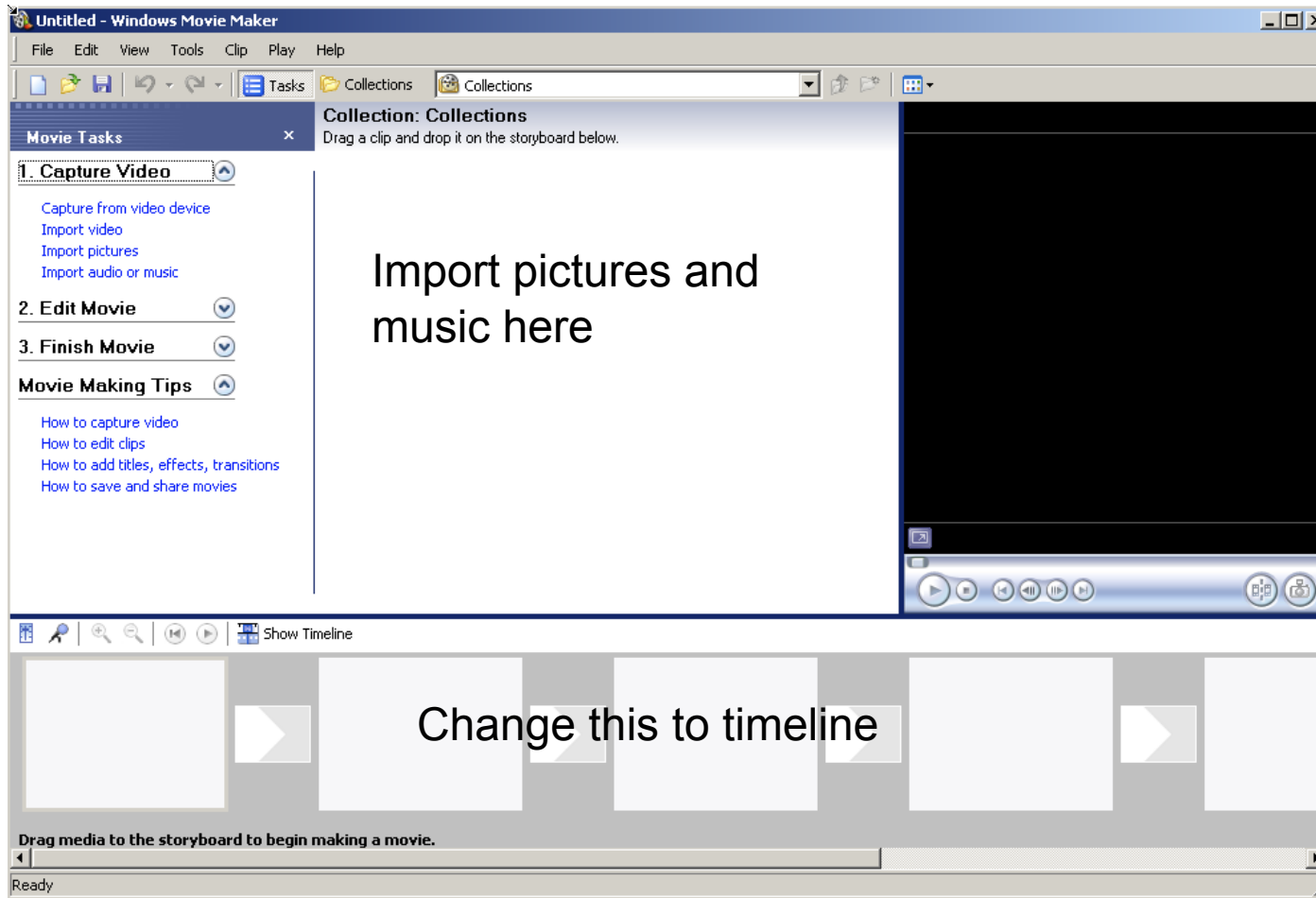

# Titles & Credits

- Tools menu
- Titles & Credits
- Choose Titles to start with
- Type the Titles in the boxes
- Choose Change the Title Animation

# Soundtrack

- Expand the storyboard section to maximum
- Note the music volume intensity markings
- Identify the beginning of a new section (bar) - listen, look
- Choose the method of transition
- Adjust the slide transition to sync with the music

# Simple Transitions

- Fade in/Fade out
- Overlay
- Keep to just two or three transitions
- Bad transitions detract from the impact of the show
- Play the soundtrack and review the transition point
- Adjust as necessary
- Review again etc
- Move on to the next slide

# Listen to the Music

- Think of your slides as supporting the rhythm of the music
- Match the words of the song if you can
- Don't be afraid of a bit of humour
- LISTEN – there is natural rhythm to the music

# Text

- Don't be afraid to introduce text if it is needed to explain a slide
- Overlay text or make up a section heading slide
