

Resizing an image in Lightroom.


In Lightroom choose your image to be resized.




Next, go to the FILE dropdown list and into EXPOTR, as shown below.




This will open up the dialogue box (below)



Select CHOOSE. This opens your path to where you require the image to be stored. I suggest you set up a directory called CCG Competitions, within this you can have any number of sub folders you require. I suggest a folder for each month of the competition.




Choose SEPTEMBER (or whatever you decide to call it) and then hit SELECT FOLDER as shown



Now scroll down to IMAGE SIZING, click on RESIZING TO FIT and choose SHORT EDGE as shown above. Type in 1080in the box.

Select



Select PIXELS and set to RESOLUTION to 72 PIXELS PER INCH.

Finally click SAVE and your done. Your resized image will now be in the directory you directed it to. Your original image still remains intact within Lightroom.
